The purpose of the conference is to be a Nordic interdisciplinary meeting place for existentially oriented research on health, culture, religion, spirituality, ecology and other related fields. Existential approaches are on the agenda and vital within a number of disciplines and practices. The idea behind this conference is that we can meet, tell each other about our research, learn from each other, and together contribute to further research and knowledge development in our related fields.

The conference builds on the psychology of religion conferences, which have been arranged annually since 2007. This year, the conference asks what it means to be human in a time of crises. This relates to the global situation of war and ecological threats, as well as to individual human crises associated with illness or other forms of suffering. However, all themes within the broad spectrum of existential approaches are welcome for presentations at the conference.

A scientific group will review the abstracts and respond within 12 June. It is possible to submit earlier, in case you need an earlier decision of acceptance for your institution. You are also welcome to have meetings in established research groups at the conference. Feel free to us contact if more information is needed.

The final keynote will be chosen from the submitted abstracts by the scientific committee and the organizers.
